the world of avant – garde music and performance. A multi – instrumentalist, builder of bizarre sonic devices, and master of transformative live experiences, Farché's work dissects genres, destroys conventions, and reshapes the battered core of musical expression. Since 2004, under the *Anklepants* moniker, over 20 boundary – pushing recordings have been released, starting with the debut album procession on their own masses imprint. Sonic evolution continued with the 2011 vinyl release of insideyourfacedubstepbeanstalktoheavenfortheatheist on the UK's mission RECORDS, culminating in the most recent was 2018) on procession was a supersided on an IDM label that, much like Farché's sound, pushes the limits of electronic experimentation.

Farché's relocation to Europe in 2009 marked a shift from underground cult figure to global provocateur. An iconic figure emerged after the notorious Boiler Room performance in Berlin in 2014, with *Anklepants* appearing on records alongside experimental legends like **LOCHEN ARBEIT** (Einstürzende Neubauten). Performances — ranging from the legendary **GLASTONEURY FESTIVAL** to **HOUSTON'S DAY FOR NIGHT FESTIVAL** — have seen Farché share stages with artists such as **APHEX TWIN, JOHN CARPENTER** and **EURE**, each performance an exercise in sonic chaos and synaptic overload. Farché's unique brand of subversive art has caught the eye of mainstream media, including **CONAN O'BRIEN'S** and **ABULT SWING Exception**. In 2019, Farché expanded their reach to South America, cementing their place as an international avant – garde icon.

At the core of Farché's artistic vision lies the *Metadexterial Instrument System* — a self – built, mind – bending array of hardware and software instrumentation that functions as an extension of their body, brain, and consciousness. In its fifth iteration, the system includes a custom "microphone controller," a body – tracking "Suit" and "Shoes" that capture the most finite of movements — heart rate, footsteps, hand gestures — all feeding into a continuous stream of high – resolution data. This system allows Farché to manipulate voice, rhythms, and effects in real-time, blurring and defining the boundaries between body, instrument, voice and space.

Farché's performances, with over 100 real – time wireless inputs, converge into a hyper – immersive, multi – faceted soundscape. With the body itself as the chassis of the instrument — an instrument with more limbs than humanly possible — each performance is an unpredictable, ever – shifting act of improvisation.

Collaboration remains a key element of the work, as seen in the 2019 reinterpretation of Frockmattor by British prog – rock legends *GENTLE GIANT* where vocal acrobatics are paired with the electronic stylings of Mr. Bill. As ever, Farché's art is fluid, ever – changing, and elusive, with forthcoming work integrating sounds inspired by Australian wildlife and the communication of birds and Native Australian animals — elements that have increasingly infiltrated live shows in recent years.

Constantly on the bleeding edge of sound and instrument design, Farché is already working on new creations: *Teeth* — a percussion instrument utilizing the playability of Farché's own teeth — and the *Reecard Farché Intonarumori*, a breath – controlled, motorized string instrument. The latest iteration of the *Metadexterial Instrument System* has expanded to *100 input channels*, pushing the boundaries of what's possible with a single tool. Meanwhile, the *Suit V4* and *Shoe V2* enhance the body's capacity to modulate sound, adding granular controls and more nuanced input from every limb and joint. Farché's mechanical creations — three new characters yet to be completed — promise to further destabilize and expand the live experience, ensuring that the evolution continues.

Reecard Farché, through *Anklepants*, continues to challenge the limits of expression. The work exists at the intersection of technology, chaos, and human expression, a surrealist collision of sound, movement, and visual feedback that shatters expectations. The art is not simply music; it is an ongoing exploration of perception, identity, and reality — an absurdist and often unsettling journey into the depths of sound and the human psyche.
